

# Growing up in the 1940s

## HOW TO MAKE PAPER CHAIN DOLLS

Children growing up in the 1940's had to be creative with their crafts and had to make use of limited resources.

Making paper chain dolls is a classic craft activity for all children.

Take an A4 piece of paper and cut it in half length ways.

Fold it into quarters.

Draw a figure of a person on the top layer. Make sure that the arms extend all the way to the edge of the paper.

Cut the figure out and unfold the paper carefully.

You will have a chain of dolls holding hands.

You can decorate you dolls, giving them some hair, a nose, eyes, mouth, and colour in their clothing.
